Marsulex Environmental Technologies Receives Export Achievement Certificate

Lebanon, Pennsylvania – November 5, 2009 – The U.S. Department of Commerce has awarded Marsulex Environmental Technologies (MET) the U.S. Commercial Service’s Export Achievement Certificate acknowledging MET’s success in developing its international business. Presented by U.S. Congressman Tim Holden, the certificate recognizes companies that have worked with the U.S. Commercial Service to develop business solutions that break into the export area, or increase export markets and sales.

In presenting the certificate, Congressman Holden stated that “We live in a global economy and have to be able to compete in a global economy. Selling advanced technologies is one way we can compete, and that is what MET has done so well. He also stated that “Combined with our licensees and the work that we have done directly, we are responsible for a worldwide capture of approximately 10 million tons of SO₂ per year. This is the equivalent of all the U.S. power plants together in what they emit today. That is a tremendous achievement.”
